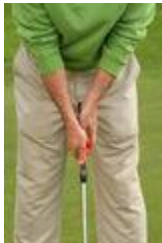

Zach Johnson is a great putter with a great natural feel for speed which is why he was able to tame Augusta National. Together we have built a system on the greens that leads to holing more putts, not just on random days, but with a degree of consistency. Our method relies on keeping the stroke natural and simple. I'll show you how. The key to great putting, building a system that allows you to set the ball on an accurate path as frequently as possible. My theory is built around the [SeeMore](#) putter, which has markings to help you check alignment.



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
